LHA Room Allowance/Under Occupation Criteria

One bedroom is awarded for each category below:

- Every adult couple
- Any other adult aged 16 or over
- Any two children of the same sex (under the age of 16)
- Any two children, regardless of sex (under the age of 10)
- Any other child

One Bedroom Shared Rate:

The one-bedroom shared accommodation rate applies to single people or couples with no dependants who live in a property where they have their own room which no one else can use and share other rooms. Or they are single and under 35, where they have more than one room for sole use but do not satisfy any exemption conditions.

One Bedroom Self Contained rate:

The one-bedroom self-contained accommodation rate applies to single people over 35, or a couple, with no dependents who live in a property where they have more than one room for sole use.

Exemptions apply if you are:

- Severely disabled or live with a severely disabled partner and have no dependent children.
- A care leaver under 25 or live with a care leaver under 25 who is your partner and has no dependent children.
